- **THE PROGRAM**

Each year, the Fulton County Federal Credit Union awards (4) \$1,000 scholarships to those candidates who have demonstrated academic merit and who have engaged in community service upholding the Credit Union philosophy of *"people helping people."* Scholarship winners will be required to submit their letter of acceptance, and proof of full-time status from the college they will be attending. Awards will be sent directly to the college for the benefit of the student upon proof of full-time status.

- **ELIGIBILITY**

The applicant must be:

- A credit union member and in good standing with the credit union.
- A first-time college bound student.
- Age 21 or younger.

- **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Check each box after completion

1. The applicant and his/her parent or guardian must sign the Certification and Release Authorization
2. The signed application must be submitted together with:
 - ___ Sealed official high school transcript and unweighted GPA.
 - ___ Applicant's credit union essay.
 - ___ Teacher's letter of reference. (2) Required.
3. The application, transcript, essay and letter of recommendation must be returned by the application deadline. If any portion is incomplete or not included, the application will not be considered.

- **SELECTION PROCESS**

Judging will be based on the applicant's academic performance, personal essay, community activities, honors and awards, and letters of recommendation.

- **APPLICATION DEADLINE**

Application must be returned to the Credit Union no later than **Friday, May 7, 2010.**
